- **Order your cap and gown for graduation from Balfour.**
- **Balfour is delivering the graduation invitations that you ordered on April 8 at lunch in the auditorium foyer.**
- **Visit Dave & Busters from 6-8 PM on April 13 and 10% of the profits go to the after prom, or just stay home and write a donation check.**
- **Senior dues are \$95. Half of the senior class has paid their dues.**
- **Students who want to be exempt from final exams must fill out an exemption form and meet the grade, conduct and attendance qualifications. Two days of college visits will be allowed for the exemption.**
- **The Prom, titled “Take a Chance”, will be held at the Westin Galleria from 8 PM to midnight on Saturday, May 15. It is a formal affair. The boys should be in a suit or a tux. The girls should be in cocktail or formal dress. Students must have an ID when checking in. Students will have to check in by 10 PM. Once a student leaves, they will not be able to return.**
- **The After Prom will be held at Dave & Busters on Richmond from 1 AM to 5:30 AM on Sunday, May 16. Students will have changing rooms at the Prom. Students should wear acceptable casual clothing. A bus will loop between the Westin and Dave & Busters throughout the morning so students can go without taking cars. It is acceptable to take a car to Dave & Busters. Students will begin to check in at 12 midnight and must show up no later than 1:30 to come to After Prom. Once a student leaves the After Prom, they will not be allowed to re-enter. Your parent contact for After Prom is Cindi Denman. After Prom is run by the parents of the 2010 class and it is a safe alcohol and drug free environment to give our students a fun experience with their friends and an opportunity to win great prizes.**

- **The final transcript will be free. Order this from Ms. Farmer by May 27.**

Even if they are exempt, they must show up for the senior activities to be counted present and not jeopardize their exemption status because of the attendance rule. On Monday, May 24 at 10 AM, seniors will practice their processional march at the auditorium. On Tuesday, May 25 at 12:30, seniors will take their cap and gown panoramic pictures on the basketball court. On Wednesday, May 26 from 11 – 2, seniors will enjoy lunch at the cafeteria and pick up their Prom and panoramic pictures. On Thursday, May 27 at 10:30 there will be an Awards Assembly and a panel discussion from students who are Bellaire graduates.**
- **Graduation will be held at the Reliant on Sunday, May 30 at 1 PM. Students are required to arrive an hour early to get lined up. No student will be allowed to carry in a bag or a purse. There is plenty of seating so no tickets are required. Flip flops and tennis shoes are not appropriate.**
